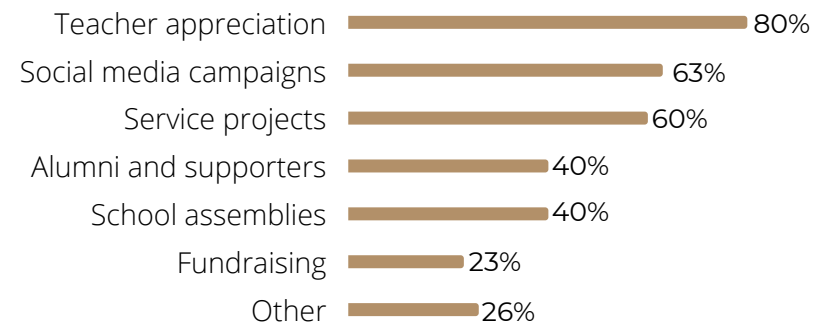
Celebrating National FFA Week Locally

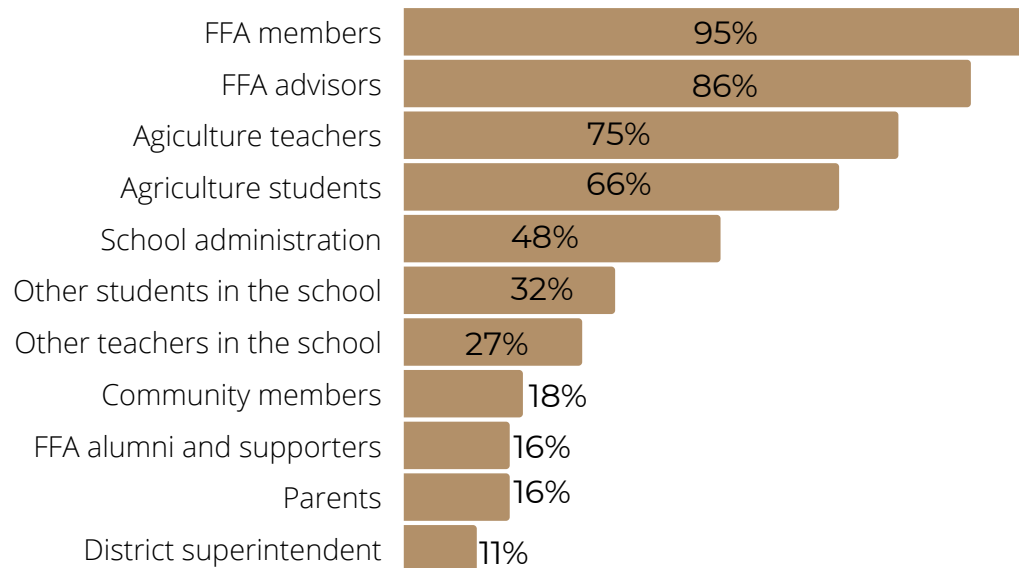
2022 FFA Week National Days of Service

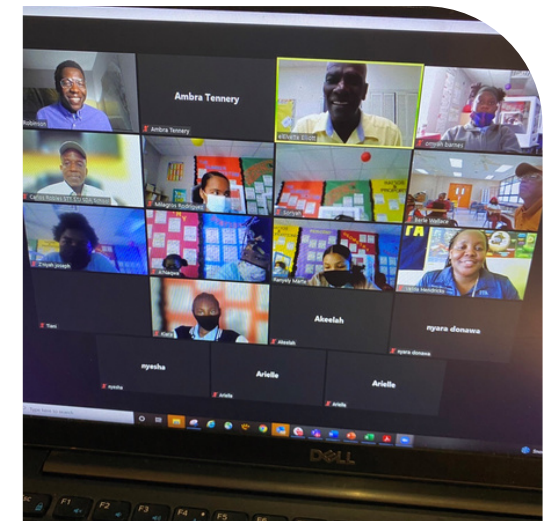
