Scenario: Rank these Angus females as they will be used for the production of purebred Angus heifers and bulls. The primary source of income for the operation is their annual bull sale each December. Their customer base is focused on replacement females, both to keep and to sell to other commercial cattlemen, with emphasis placed on a balance of growth and calving ease in an eye appealing package. The operation also markets their registered females through a spring production sale featuring elite embryo calves and all 6 year old cows. Labor and feed resources are adequate.
