OFFICER	ORAL QUESTION	ANSWERS TO ORAL QUESTIONS
President	1. According to Roberts Rules of Order Newly Revised, <i>Previous Question</i> can be applied in any of three different ways. The first is to any immediately pending debatable or amendable motion. What is one of the two other applications?	- To an entire series of pending debatable or amendable motions; (All pending business) - To any consecutive part of a series of pending debatable or amendable motions, beginning with the immediately pending question.
Vice President	What are the last two steps in the consideration of a <i>Main Motion</i> as stated in the current edition of <i>Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised</i> ?	Step 2: The chair <i>puts the question</i> (or puts it to a vote). Step 3: The chair <i>announces the result</i> of the vote.
Secretary	The content in the chair's announcement of the result of a vote on a <i>Main Motion</i> has three parts. The last part states the effect of the vote. What are the first two parts in order?	1st Part: Report of the voting (which side has it). 2nd Part: A declaration that the motion is adopted or lost.
Treasurer	Which two of the following motions require a second? <i>Division of the Assembly</i> <i>Parliamentary Inquiry</i> <i>Previous Question</i> <i>Commit or Refer</i>	The two motions that require a second are: <i>Previous Question.</i> <i>Commit or Refer</i>
Reporter	A member rises and addresses the chair saying that he "rises to a question of privilege ...", and the chair immediately directs the member to state his question of privilege. The chair must then rule on two things before granting or denying the request. What is one of those two items?	- Whether the request or motion is in fact a question of privilege and, if so, - Whether it is urgent enough to interrupt the pending business.
Sentinel	What are <u>four</u> of the six duties of the Sentinel as listed in the <i>Official FFA Manual</i> ?	The duties of the Sentinel are: - Assist the president in maintaining order. - Keep the meeting room, chapter equipment and supplies in proper condition. - Welcome guests and visitors. - Keep the meeting room comfortable. - Take charge of candidates for degree ceremonies. - Assist with special features and refreshments.
Advisor (Student)	Name two subsidiary motions that may not be amended or interrupt a member speaking.	Subsidiary motions that may not be amended or interrupt a member who is speaking: <i>Previous Question.</i> <i>Postpone Indefinitely.</i> <i>Lay on the Table.</i>
