A system by which people purchase a share from a local farm and periodically receive vegetables and other agricultural products throughout the farming season	Community Supported Agriculture (CSA)
Something that is to be expressed through some medium, as speech, writing or any of various arts	Content
A condition of general emotional dejection and withdrawal; sadness greater and more prolonged than that warranted by any objective reason	Depression

An economic and social condition of ready access by all members of a household to nutritionally adequate and safe food	Food Security
Something granted, as a privilege or right, a sum of money or a tract of land	Grant

Of or pertaining to the relations between persons; existing or occurring between persons	Interpersonal
A formal meeting in which one or more persons question, consult or evaluate another person	Interview
