



TEAM ACTIVITY - ISSUES PRESENTATION

Instructions:

Below is the issue on which your team is to discuss and prepare a written and oral presentation.

Allow up to 60 minutes to prepare the presentation, including the written statement and oral presentation. Your written statement may be written as a presentation in paragraphs or as bullet points any manner that works best for your team. Submit your written statement as a Google Doc, (Create your document by selecting the "+" below and selecting **Docs**.) Save your document with your state name, i.e. Nevada Food Waste Topic.

When the team is finished preparing, record your presentation. You have maximum of 8 minutes to present plus about 5 minutes for the questions. When you have completed your presentation, your proctor will then hand you the 3 questions. The students will then respond to each question, reading the question first, then responding. Any of the team members can provide the answer. When the students have completed the questions, stop the recording. Your team should then upload the recording to YouTube saving it as an unlisted video and submit the unlisted YouTube URL link using the Google form in the Classroom.

Your Topic is:

Food Waste: from farm to fork.

You are members of a small active farming community, and you hold a leadership role in that community. Food waste is becoming a pressing issue that the community members have brought to your attention. They would like your team to design specific measures and detail what and where you would implement these ideas in order to better manage food waste in your community. Your team will present these plans at the next town hall meeting.
