FEEDING DIRECTIONS:

Thoroughly mix 86 pounds of this Monensin Type B medicated feed with 1914 pounds of non-medicated feed to obtain one ton of Type C medicated feed containing 30.0 g/ton Monensin. Feed the resulting Type C feed at the rate of 14 to 20 pounds per head per day to provide 210 to 300 mg monensin per head per day.

WARNING:

A withdrawal period has not been established for this product in pre-ruminating calves. Do not use in calves to be processed for veal.

CAUTION:

Do not allow horses or other equines access to feed containing monensin. Ingestion of monensin by horses has been fatal. Monensin medicated cattle and goat feeds are safe for use in cattle and goats only. Must be thoroughly mixed in feeds before use. Do not feed undiluted. Do not exceed the levels of monensin recommended in the feeding directions.

IMPORTANT:

This product is to be fed only to the animal species as directed on this label. Follow these management practices:

1. Provide adequate bunk space for each animal. Feeders/bunks should be well protected and managed to prevent accumulation of fines and wet, moldy feed.
2. When making a ration change, allow 7-10 days for animals to adjust to the new ration.
3. Provide a source of fresh, clean water at all times.
4. Provide mineral and salt free choice.
5. Consult your veterinarian for recommended health program for your local area.
6. Have feed before cattle at all times. In groups of cattle, there are certain animals that experience chronic bloat or other digestive disturbances and consequently, are poor performers. In addition, excess feed consumption, severe weather changes resulting in erratic feed consumption, and poorly managed feeding practices can increase the incidence of bloat in all cattle. If bloat occurs, please review feed management practices.

USAGE TIPS:

SteakMaker® BP Balancer 25 is a beef supplement for growing and finishing cattle. It is ideal for use in moderate to low grain diets with high levels of grain by-product ingredients. It can fit well in these diets when fed with a wide range of roughage sources. It is typically fed at 0.5 to 0.75 pounds per head per day depending on the nutrient profile of other ration ingredients, ration energy content, age and size of cattle being fed and the medicated option used.

All ration adjustments should be made on a gradual basis. Use good bunk management techniques and procedures to prevent digestive disturbances and to optimize dry matter intake and animal performance. SteakMaker® BP Balancer 25 should be thoroughly mixed with grain and roughage. Do not top dress or feed separately. Follow label directions for mixing instructions.

KEY POINTS:

- Use in low grain rations with high amounts of grain by-product ingredients where rumen degradable protein and extra calcium are needed
- Moderate feed rate can help lower cost of supplementation and may improve cost of gain
- Pelleted to reduce ingredient separation risks
- Provides proper level of vitamins, minerals and feed additives when fed according to label directions
