As a team, review the materials provided and work together to prepare for your 10 minute presentation. You will have 10 minutes at this station.

TEAM SCENARIO-SHOW MANAGEMENT

Your chapter is sponsoring an open horse show, which includes walk-trot, junior, senior, and adult divisions in western, hunt seat, and saddle seat. The trail class is to be held in the main ring.

Your group's task is to design the trail course for those in the junior, senior, and adult divisions with the materials available on the show grounds. Also indicate what modifications are made for the walk-trot participants.

The list of materials is provided on a separate hand-out. Design a trail course that participants will perform individually. The course should be a test of the horse and rider's ability to function as a team over a variety of obstacles and at a variety of gaits.

You do not need to use all the materials. You must include the following in your course:

- Walk
- Trot
- Canter on both leads (not for walk-trot participants).
- Halt
- 2 changes of direction
- at least 5 obstacles that test a horse and rider team's agility, responsiveness and trail aptitude, which participants must go around, through, or over

You have 10 minutes to plan and 10 minutes to make a presentation to the judges that includes an **explanation of your course, showing them the map and explaining the differences that would be incorporated for Walk Trot riders.**
