SCENARIO: These crossbred ewe lambs will be kept as replacements in a flock that utilizes RR rams. A goal for the operation is to have a homozygous flock of sheep that is resistant to scrapie. This operation is also beginning to implement an aggressive AI and embryo transfer program. The primary customer base are FFA/4-H club lamb exhibitors. Elite rams are sold to as stud bucks and the top 10% of ewe lambs are kept as replacements. Feed resources are mainly grass and harvested hay with some supplemental energy in the winter. Labor is abundant.
