I purchased a package of your All Natural Homemade Egg Noodles. The package states there are no artificial ingredients and they are made with whole eggs. The color of the product is a bright yellow which would lead one to believe the egg was the source of the yellow color since food coloring is not listed in your ingredient list.

I am allergic to yellow dye #6 and have had allergy symptoms in the past. I used the noodles in a casserole and almost immediately upon eating the product had wheezing, tightness in my throat and intense itching.

I had the product tested and the lab found a high level of yellow dye #6.

I have notified my local health department and filed a complaint with the government on www.foodsafety.gov. I have also warned people on Twitter about your product.
